APPROVAL OF APPLICATION A-19335

WATER DIVISION 1-F

BACKGROUND

1. On March 9, 2015, Lavon L. and Robin Heidemann, landowners, and SRK Consulting, Inc., applicants, filed in the Department of Natural Resources (Department) application A-19335 for a temporary Permit to Appropriate Water.
2. Temporary permits may not be granted for a term of more than one year.

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that application A-19335 is APPROVED subject to the following limitations and conditions:

1. The source of water is Todd Creek.
2. The water shall be used for the purpose of hydrologic testing.
3. The priority date is March 9, 2015.
4. The point of diversion is located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 34, Township 4 North, Range 11 East of the 6th P.M. in Johnson County.
5. Water may be diverted at a maximum rate of 1.56 cubic feet per second (700 gallons per minute).
6. This appropriation EXPIRES one year from the date of this Order and appropriation A-19335 will be CANCELLED without further action by the Department as of that date.


ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Failure to comply with all laws and regulations pertaining to surface water appropriations, any orders issued by the Director of the Department of Natural Resources, or the provisions of this Approval may result in the cancellation of the appropriation, temporary closing of the appropriation, administrative penalty, criminal prosecution, or any combination thereof.

This appropriation is not a guarantee that water will be available. Nebraska law gives priority to senior appropriations. This appropriation may be closed if there is insufficient water to satisfy senior appropriations.

The applicant and any person with sufficient legal interest who has been or may be substantially affected by this order may request a contested case hearing in accordance with the *Neb. Admin. Procedures Act* §§ 84-901 et. seq. RRS and the Department's *Rules of Practice and Procedure Title 454 Admin. Code Chapter 7*. The request must be received by the Department at its Lincoln office (Nebraska State Office Building, 4th Floor, 301 Centennial Mall South, P.O. Box 94676, Lincoln, Nebraska 68509-4676) within 30 days of the date of the order and be accompanied by a filing fee of \$10.
