WATER DIVISION 2-A

BACKGROUND

1. North Loup River Public Power and Irrigation District (District) holds appropriations to divert water from the North Loup River through the headgate of the Taylor-Ord Canal located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 13, Township 21 North, Range 19 West of the 6th P.M. in Loup County for the purpose of irrigation. The surface water appropriations diverted through this canal are as follows:

2. Water diverted under appropriation A-2312A shall not exceed the ratio of one cfs for every 140 acres irrigated. Total volume of water diverted may not exceed one acre-feet per acre irrigated per annum.
3. Water diverted under appropriation A-3980A⁴ shall not exceed the ratio of one cfs for every 70 acres irrigated, nor three acre-feet per acre irrigated per annum, less that fraction of a cfs and that number of acre-feet per acre per annum to which lands described in appropriation A-3980A are entitled by virtue of appropriation A-2312A.
4. The District carries water from the North Loup River through the headgate of the Taylor-Ord Canal located in the SW¹/₄NE¹/₄ of Section 13, Township 21 North, Range 19 West of the 6th P.M. in Loup County for the purpose of irrigation of the appurtenant land held under private appropriations as follows:

On March 3, 2014, the District and individual landowners filed in the Department twelve (12) Relinquishments of Water Appropriation In Part, REL-4956, REL-4957, REL-4959, REL-4960, REL-4962, REL-4963, REL-4965, REL-4968, REL-4976, REL-4977, REL-4979 and REL-4980 relinquishing the right to divert a portion of the water under both appropriations A-2312A and A-3980A¹ to irrigate 130.6 acres of land.
8. On March 3, 2014, the District and individual landowners filed in the Department fifteen (15) Relinquishments of Water Appropriation In Part, REL-4958, REL-4961, REL-4964, REL-4966, REL-4967, REL-4969 through REL-4975, REL-4978, REL-4981 and REL-4983 relinquishing the right to divert a portion of the water under appropriation A-3980A² to irrigate 108.2 acres of land.
9. On March 3, 2014, the District filed in the Department two (2) Notifications of Assignment of Rights, AOR-4954 and AOR-4955, to assign a portion of the water under both appropriations A-2312A and A-3980A¹, previously relinquished, to 114.5 acres of land.
10. On March 3, 2014, the District filed in the Department a Notification of Assignment of Rights, AOR-4953, to assign a portion of the water under appropriation A-3980A², previously relinquished, to 117.4 acres of land.

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

Water diverted under appropriation A-3980A⁴ shall not exceed the ratio of one cfs for every 70 acres irrigated at a maximum rate of 151.06 cfs, nor exceed three acre-feet per acre irrigated per annum, less that fraction of a cfs and that number of acre-feet per acre per annum to which lands described in appropriation A-3980A are entitled by virtue of appropriation A-2312A from the North Loup River under A-3980A¹ via the Taylor-Ord Canal for use upon the 10,573.9 acres and 25.76 cfs for incidental underground storage (U-3) from the North Loup River through the Taylor-Ord Canal at its headgate. All other rights remain the same.

Water appropriation A-3980A⁵ shall now be shown in Department records as a permit to divert 32.56 cfs of water for irrigation of 2,278.8 acres and 17.78 cfs for incidental underground storage (U-3) from the North Loup River through the Taylor-Ord Canal at its headgate. - A. Receiving approval prior to taking any action that changes the location of the point of diversion, a transfer of the location of the place of use, a relinquishment of a portion of the appropriation, the type of use, or the type of appropriation.
 - B. Notify the Department of Natural Resources of any reassignment of relinquished portions of an appropriation.
 - C. Comply with all relevant notices and orders of the Department.

DEADLINES

Because the District is in the process of upgrading their computer system and preparing an application for a District transfer and map according to *Neb. Rev. Stat. §§ 46-2,122 through 46-2,126*, a map must be filed in the office of the Department by December 31, 2016, depicting transfers EXT-4802, EXT-4803, and EXT-4804, prepared according to the *Department of Natural Resources Rules for Surface Water, Title 457, Neb. Admin. Code Chapter 10*.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Failure to comply with all laws and regulations pertaining to surface water appropriations and any orders issued by the Director of the Department of Natural Resources may result in the cancellation of the appropriation, temporary closing of the appropriation, administrative penalty, criminal prosecution, or any combination thereof.

Nebraska law provides that failure to use a portion or all of a perfected appropriation for five consecutive years may result in cancellation of the appropriation.
