APPROVAL OF EXPEDITED TRANSFER EXT-5352 FOR WATER APPROPRIATION A-10419

WATER DIVISION 1-C

BACKGROUND

1. Records on file in the Department of Natural Resources (Department) show that surface water appropriation A-10419 is held by Shuck Drilling Company and Diamond Seven Corporation. The owners have filed an allowance for joint ownership for appropriation A-10419.
2. Appropriation A-10419 has a priority date of August 6, 1964, and authorizes the use of water for irrigation of the 43.0 acres of land described below. The water may be diverted from the Little Blue River at points of diversion located on both banks of the stream in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 18, Township 4 North, Range 6 West of the 6th P.M. in Nuckolls County. Water diverted shall not exceed the ratio of one cubic foot per second (cfs) for every 70 acres irrigated at a maximum rate of 0.61 cfs from all points of diversion.

3. On June 3, 2015, Dale Shuck, on behalf of Shuck Drilling and Diamond Seven Corporation, filed application EXT-5352 for a permit for an expedited transfer of the location of use for land authorized to be irrigated by appropriation A-10419.
4. On July 14, 2015, Dennis Shuck, on behalf of Shuck Drilling and Diamond Seven Corporation, filed map number 19299 showing the land proposed to be irrigated under appropriation A-10419 through transfer EXT-5352.

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

1. Application EXT-5352 for a permit for an expedited transfer of the location of use and map number 19299 are APPROVED.

2. Appropriation A-10419 through transfer EXT-5352 authorizes the use of water to irrigate 43.0 acres of land described below and depicted on map number 19299, which is made a part of this Order. The water may be diverted from the Little Blue River at points of diversion located on in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 18, Township 4 North, Range 6 West of the 6th P.M. in Nuckolls County, as depicted on map number 19299. Water diverted shall not exceed the ratio of one cfs for every 70 acres irrigated at a maximum combined rate of 0.61 cfs from all points of diversion (273 gallons per minute). The total combined volume may not exceed 3 acre-feet per irrigated acre per year; not to exceed the least amount of water necessary for the production of crops in the exercise of good husbandry.

3. All terms and conditions of appropriation A-10419 remain in effect unless specifically changed by this Order.
4. The appropriator must comply with all relevant statutes. This includes, but is not limited to, the following:
- A. Notify the Department of any change in ownership or address.
 - B. Notify the Department of the name and address of the person responsible for the use of the water appropriation (this may include farm managers, tenants, or relatives that actually apply the water to the approved use).
 - C. Obtain approval from the Department prior to taking any action that changes the location of the point of diversion, the location of the place of use, the type of use, or the type of appropriation.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Failure to comply with all laws and regulations pertaining to surface water appropriations, any orders issued by the Director of the Department of Natural Resources, or the provisions of this Approval may cause cancellation of part or all of this appropriation, temporary closing of the appropriation, administrative penalty, criminal prosecution, or any combination thereof.

Nebraska law provides that failure to use an appropriation for more than five consecutive years may result in cancellation of the appropriation.

This appropriation is not a guarantee that water will be available. Nebraska law gives priority to senior appropriations. This appropriation may be closed if there is insufficient water to satisfy senior appropriations.

Box 94676, Lincoln, Nebraska 68509-4676) within 30 days of the date of the order and be accompanied by a filing fee of \$10.
