ORDER DIVIDING AND CHANGING OWNERSHIP OF APPROPRIATION A-16907

WATER DIVISION 2-B

Background

1. Records on file in the Department of Natural Resources (Department) show that surface water appropriation A-16907 is currently held by Lowell Schroeder.
2. Appropriation A-16907 has a priority date of January 2, 1990, and authorizes the use of water for irrigation of the 77.8 acres of land described below. The water may be diverted from Union Creek at points of diversion located on the right bank of the stream in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ and the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 14, Township 22 North, Range 1 East of the 6th P.M. in Stanton County. The rate that water may be diverted shall not exceed one cubic foot per second (cfs) for every 70 acres irrigated at a maximum combined rate of 1.11 cfs from all points of diversion. Total annual volume of water diverted may not exceed 3 acre-feet per acre irrigated.

3. Paul R. and Patricia A. Renner filed a Notice of Change of Ownership indicating that they are the owners of a portion of the land authorized to be irrigated by appropriation A-16907.

Order

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

1. Appropriation A-16907 is divided into two appropriations, A-16907A and A-16907B.

2. Appropriation A-16907A is held by Paul R. and Patricia A. Renner.

A. They are allowed to divert 0.45 cfs (202 gallons per minute) from Union Creek to irrigate the 31.3 acres of land described below and as depicted on map number 17578 which is hereby made a part of this Order. The total rate that water may be diverted shall not exceed one cfs per 70 acres irrigated. Total annual volume of water diverted may not exceed 3 acre-feet per acre irrigated.

B. All terms and conditions of appropriation A-16907 remain in effect unless specifically changed by this Order.

C. The points of diversion remain on the right bank of Union Creek in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ and the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 14, Township 22 North, Range 1 East of the 6th P.M. in Stanton County. If the owners of appropriation A-16907A do not have access to these points of diversion, they must either obtain permission from the landowner or apply for a new point of diversion. This Order does not authorize access to the existing points of diversion.

3. Appropriation A-16907B is held by Lowell Schroeder.

A. He is allowed to divert 0.66 cfs (296 gallons per minute) from Union Creek to irrigate the 46.5 acres of land described below and as depicted on map number 17579 which is hereby made a part of this Order. The total rate that water may be diverted shall not exceed one cfs per 70 acres irrigated. Total annual volume of water diverted may not exceed 3 acre-feet per acre irrigated.

B. All terms and conditions of appropriation A-16907 remain in effect unless specifically changed by this Order.

C. The points of diversion remain on the right bank of Union Creek in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ and the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 14, Township 22 North, Range 1 East of the 6th P.M. in Stanton County. If the owner of appropriation A-16907B does not have access to these points of diversion, he must either obtain permission from the landowner or apply for a new point of diversion. This Order does not authorize access to the existing points of diversion.
