ORDER OF CANCELLATION IN FULL OF WATER APPROPRIATION A-17202

WATER DIVISION 2-A

Background

Records on file in the Department of Natural Resources (Department) show that surface water appropriation A-17202 is held by J. M. Christensen.

1. Appropriation A-17202 authorizes the use of water for irrigation of the 41 acres of land described below. The water may be diverted from Mud (Beaver) Creek at points of diversion located on banks of the stream in the N1/2NW1/4 of Section 13, Township 16 North, Range 20 West of the 6th P.M. in Custer County, Nebraska. The rate that water may be diverted shall not exceed one cubic foot per second (cfs) for every 70 acres irrigated at a maximum rate of 0.59 cfs.


2. On March 16, 2009, the Department issued a Notice of Preliminary Determination of Nonuse of appropriation A-17202. The notice was delivered by certified mail to J. M. Christensen, 1950 West Ridge Drive, Broken Bow, NE 68822.
3. No contest of the Preliminary Determination of Nonuse was received in the Department.
4. Nebraska Revised Statutes Section 46-229.02, provides that an appropriation not used for a beneficial purpose for more than five consecutive years may be cancelled.
