APPROVAL OF MAP 17155 FOR WATER APPROPRIATION A-17901

WATER DIVISION 1-A

Background

1. On February 22, 2007, The Department of Natural Resources (Department) approved application A-17901.
2. On June 20, 2007, Michael Kleffner, Olsson Associates, on behalf of Central Platte Natural Resources District (District), filed map number 17155 showing the project proposed under appropriation A-17901.

Order

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

1. Map number 17155 is APPROVED.
2. Appropriation A-17901 is held by the District, and authorizes it to divert a maximum of 4,200 cubic feet per second of flood flows from Wood River at a point in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 32, Township 11 North, Range 8 West of the 6<sup>th</sup> P.M. in Hall County. The flood water will travel eastward in a channel constructed through Sections 32, 33, 34, 35 and 36, all in Township 11 North, Range 8 West of the 6<sup>th</sup> P.M. in Hall County, to where the channel empties into the Middle Channel of the Platte River in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 36, Township 11 North, Range 8 West of the 6<sup>th</sup> P.M. in Hall County. Map number 17155 depicts the location and cross section of the channel and is made a part of this Order.
3. The appropriator is bound by all terms and conditions of the approval of application A-17901.
4. The appropriator must comply with all relevant statutes. This includes, but is not limited to, the following.
  - a. Notify the Department of any change in ownership or address.
  - b. Notify the Department of the name and address of the person responsible for the use of the water appropriation.
  - c. Obtain approval from the Department prior to taking any action that changes the location of the point of diversion, the location of the place of use, the type of use, or the type of appropriation.
