APPROVAL OF MAP 17155B FOR WATER APPROPRIATION A-17903

WATER DIVISION 1-A

Background

1. On February 22, 2007, The Department of Natural Resources (Department) approved application A-17903.
2. On June 20, 2007, Michael Kleffner, Olsson Associates, on behalf of Central Platte Natural Resources District (District), filed map number 17155B showing the project proposed under appropriation A-17903.

Order

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

1. Map number 17155B is APPROVED.
2. Appropriation A-17903 is held by the District, and authorizes it to divert a maximum of 1,480 cubic feet per second of flood flows from Lower Warm Slough at a point in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 24, Township 13 North, Range 7 West of the 6th P.M. in Merrick County. The flood water will travel eastward in a channel constructed through Section 24, Township 13 North, Range 7 West of the 6th P.M. in Merrick County, and through Sections 15, 16, 17, 18, 19, and 22, all in Township 13 North, Range 6 West of the 6th P.M. in Merrick County, to where the channel empties into the Platte River in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 22, Township 13 North, Range 6 West of the 6th P.M. in Merrick County. Map number 17155B depicts the location and cross section of the channel and is made a part of this Order.
3. The appropriator is bound by all terms and conditions of the approval of application A-17903.
4. The appropriator must comply with all relevant statutes. This includes, but is not limited to, the following.
 - a. Notify the Department of any change in ownership or address.
 - b. Notify the Department of the name and address of the person responsible for the use of the water appropriation.
 - c. Obtain approval from the Department prior to taking any action that changes the location of the point of diversion, the location of the place of use, the type of use, or the type of appropriation.
