APPROVAL OF APPLICATION A-18617

WATER DIVISION 2-F

Background

On November 18, 2008, Tom J. Moser, Manager of the Lewis and Clark Natural Resources District, on behalf of landowner Bill Schaefer, filed application A-18617 in the Department of Natural Resources (Department) for a permit to appropriate water and map number 17323 showing land proposed to be irrigated under this application.

Order

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that application A-18617 is APPROVED subject to the following limitations and conditions:

1. The source of water is Antelope Creek Lake, constructed under storage appropriation A-16462.
2. The water shall be used for the purpose of irrigation.
3. The priority date is November 18, 2008.
4. Only the land shown on map number 17323 may be irrigated under appropriation A-18617.
5. This appropriation will be limited to the land irrigated and the amount of water beneficially used on an annual basis. Such amount shall not exceed 67 acre-feet per year.
6. The appropriator must comply with all relevant statutes. This includes, but is not limited to, the following:
 - a. Notify the Department of any change in ownership or address.
 - b. Notify the Department of the name and address of the person responsible for the use of the water appropriation (this may include farm managers, tenants, or relatives that actually apply the water to the approved use).
 - c. Getting approval from the Department prior to taking any action that changes the location of the point of diversion, the location of the place of use, the type of use, or the type of appropriation.
