APPROVAL OF MAP 17432 FOR WATER APPROPRIATION A-18662

WATER DIVISION 2-F

Background

1. On May 4, 2009, Rodney G. Tramp, filed on behalf of Bert A. Tramp, landowner, application A-18662 in the Department of Natural Resources (Department) for a Permit to Appropriate Water.
2. On July 6, 2009, Bert A. Tramp filed map number 17432 showing land proposed to be irrigated under application A-18662.

Order

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

1. Map number 17432 is APPROVED.
2. The following land is authorized to be irrigated (appurtenant land) under surface water appropriation A-18662 as depicted on map number 17432 which is made a part of this Order.

3. Appropriation A-18662 is held by Bert A. Tramp and authorizes the use of water for irrigation of the 210.0 acres of land described above. The water may be diverted from Beaver Creek at a point of diversion in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 28, Township 33 North, Range 1 West of the 6<sup>th</sup> P.M. in Cedar County at a maximum rate of 3.0 cubic foot per second (cfs) (1,346 gallons per minute). The rate that water may be diverted shall not exceed one cfs for every 70 acres irrigated and an annual volume not to exceed 3 acre-feet per acre irrigated.
