APPROVAL OF MAP 17443 FOR WATER APPROPRIATION A-18668

WATER DIVISION 2-F

Background

1. On June 15, 2009, Stan and Cheryl Sudbeck filed application A-18668 in the Department of Natural Resources (Department) for a Permit to Appropriate Water.
2. On July 8, 2009, Stan and Cheryl Sudbeck filed map number 17443 showing land proposed to be irrigated under application A-18668.

Order

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

1. Map number 17443 is APPROVED.
2. The following land is authorized to be irrigated (appurtenant land) under surface water appropriation A-18668 as depicted on map number 17443 which is made a part of this Order.

Township 30 North, Range 3 East of the  
6<sup>th</sup> P.M. in Cedar County Acres

Section 7: NW~~1~~NW~~4~~ 33.2

3. Appropriation A-18668 is held by Stan and Cheryl Sudbeck and authorizes the use of water for irrigation of the 33.2 acres of land described above. The water may be diverted from a tributary to East Bow Creek at a point of diversion in the NW~~1~~NW~~4~~ of Section 7, Township 30 North, Range 3 East of the 6<sup>th</sup> P.M. in Cedar County at a maximum rate of 0.47 cubic foot per second (cfs) (211 gallons per minute). The rate that water may be diverted shall not exceed one cfs for every 70 acres irrigated and an annual volume not to exceed 3 acre-feet per acre irrigated.
