APPROVAL OF MAP 17673 FOR WATER APPROPRIATION A-18703

WATER DIVISION 1-C

BACKGROUND

1. On May 20, 2010, Marilyn S. Corman filed in the Department of Natural Resources (Department) application A-18703 for a Permit to Appropriate Water.
2. On June 3, 2010, Marilyn S. Corman filed map number 17673 showing land proposed to be irrigated under application A-18703.

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

1. Map number 17673 is APPROVED.
2. The following land is authorized to be irrigated (appurtenant land) under surface water appropriation A-18703 as depicted on map number 17673 which is made a part of this Order.

3. Appropriation A-18703 authorizes the appropriator the use of water for irrigation of the 96.8 acres of land described above. The water may be diverted from the Little Blue River at a point of diversion on the right bank of the stream in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 34, Township 4 North, Range 6 West of the 6<sup>th</sup> P.M. in Nuckolls County, at a maximum rate of 1.38 cubic feet per second (cfs) (619 gallons per minute).

4. The rate that water may be diverted shall not exceed one cfs for every 70 acres irrigated nor the least amount of water necessary for the production of crops in the exercise of good husbandry. Therefore, in any year when less than the maximum permitted acres are being irrigated, the quantity of water diverted at any time may be restricted to 1/70 cfs for each permitted acre being irrigated that year. This appropriation of water under any circumstance shall be limited annually to three acre-feet per acre of land on which water is actually and beneficially applied.
5. The appropriator is bound by all terms and conditions of the approval of application A-18703.
