ORDER OF CANCELLATION IN FULL OF WATER APPROPRIATION A-17730

WATER DIVISION 2-A

BACKGROUND

1. Records on file in the Department of Natural Resources (Department) show that surface water appropriation A-17730 is held by Cortez Lewis.
2. Appropriation A-17730 has a priority date of February 5, 1999, and authorizes the use of water for irrigation of the 92 acres of land described below. The water may be diverted from Mud (Beaver) Creek at points of diversion located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ and NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 29, Township 14 North, Range 16 West of the 6th P.M. in Sherman County. Water diverted shall not exceed the ratio of one cubic foot per second (cfs) for every 287 acres irrigated at a maximum combined rate of 0.32 cfs from all points of diversion.

3. On July 29, 2013, Cortez Lewis filed a Relinquishment of Water Appropriation, REL-4789, in the office of the Department relinquishing the right to divert water under appropriation A-17730 for use upon the land described above.
