ORDER OF CANCELLATION IN FULL OF WATER APPROPRIATION A-18700

WATER DIVISION 2-F

BACKGROUND

1. Records on file in the Department of Natural Resources (Department) show that surface water appropriation A-18700 is held by Arlene J. Cosgrove.
2. Appropriation A-18700, with a priority date of April 12, 2010, authorizes the use of water for irrigation of the 1 acre of land described below. The water may be diverted from Little Papillion Creek at a point of diversion located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 36, Township 15 North, Range 12 East of the 6th P.M. in Douglas County. The rate that water may be diverted shall not exceed one cubic foot per second (cfs) for every 70 acres irrigated at a maximum rate of 0.01 cfs.

3. On November 9, 2011, Arlene J. Cosgrove filed a Relinquishment of Water Appropriation, REL-2214, in the office of the Department relinquishing the right to divert water under appropriation A-18700 for use upon the land described above.
