APPROVAL OF MAP 17925 FOR WATER APPROPRIATION A-18795

WATER DIVISION 2-F

BACKGROUND

1. On July 22, 2011, Darrel Pinkleman filed in the Department of Natural Resources (Department) application A-18795 for a Permit to Appropriate Water.
2. On August 29, 2011, Darrel Pinkleman filed in the Department map number 17925 showing land proposed to be irrigated under application A-18795.

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

1. Map number 17925 is APPROVED.
2. The following land is authorized to be irrigated (appurtenant land) under surface water appropriation A-18795 as depicted on map number 17925 which is made a part of this Order.

3. Appropriation A-18795 authorizes the appropriator the use of water for irrigation of the 160.2 acres of land described above. The water may be diverted from West Bow Creek at a point of diversion located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 16, Township 32 North, Range 2 East of the 6<sup>th</sup> P.M. in Cedar County, at a maximum rate of 2.29 cubic feet per second (cfs) (1,028 gallons per minute).

4. The rate that water may be diverted shall not exceed one cfs for every 70 acres irrigated nor the least amount of water necessary for the production of crops in the exercise of good husbandry. Therefore, in any year when less than the maximum permitted acres are being irrigated, the quantity of water diverted at any time may be restricted to 1/70 cfs for each permitted acre being irrigated that year. This appropriation of water under any circumstance shall be limited annually to three acre-feet per acre of land on which water is actually and beneficially applied.
5. The appropriator is bound by all terms and conditions of the approval of application A-18795.
