ORDER OF CANCELLATION IN FULL OF WATER APPROPRIATION A-2059

WATER DIVISION 2-A

BACKGROUND

1. Records on file in the Department of Natural Resources (Department) show that surface water appropriation A-2059 is held by Adams Land & Cattle Co.
2. Appropriation A-2059 has a priority date of January 3, 1929, and authorizes the use of water for irrigation of the 33.5 acres of land described below. The water may be diverted from Muddy Creek (now known as Mud Creek) at a point of diversion located on the South bank of the stream in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 18, Township 16 North, Range 19 West of the 6th P.M. in Custer County. The rate that water may be diverted shall not exceed 0.47 cubic foot per second (cfs).
