ORDER OF CANCELLATION IN FULL OF WATER APPROPRIATION A-2198

WATER DIVISION 2-F

BACKGROUND

1. Records on file in the Department of Natural Resources (Department) show that surface water appropriation A-2198 is held by Steven J. and Angela E. Keck.
2. Appropriation A-2198 has a priority date of April 17, 1931, and authorizes the use of water for irrigation of the 9.1 acres of land described below. The water may be diverted from Bazile Creek at a point of diversion located in Section 28, Township 29 North, Range 5 West of the 6<sup>th</sup> P.M. in Knox County. Water diverted shall not exceed the ratio of one cubic foot per second (cfs) for every 70 acres irrigated at a maximum rate of 0.13 cfs.
