ORDER OF CANCELLATION IN FULL OF WATER APPROPRIATION A-3115

WATER DIVISION 2-A

BACKGROUND

1. Records on file in the Department of Natural Resources (Department) show that surface water appropriation A-3115 is held by Richard P. Madsen.
2. Appropriation A-3115 has a priority date of March 12, 1940, and authorizes the use of water for irrigation of the 74.7 acres of land described below. The water may be diverted from Mud (Beaver) Creek at a point of diversion located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 28, Township 14 North, Range 16 West of the 6<sup>th</sup> P.M. in Sherman County. Water diverted shall not exceed the ratio of one cubic foot per second (cfs) for every 140 acres irrigated at a maximum rate of 0.53 cfs.

3. On December 17, 2012, Richard P. Madsen filed a Relinquishment of Water Appropriation, REL-3454, in the office of the Department relinquishing the right to divert water under appropriation A-3115 for use upon the land described above.
