BACKGROUND

1. On May 3, 2012, pursuant to *Neb. Rev. Stat. § 46-250*, Ivan Dobrinski, President of Beerline Canal Company filed petition MIP-2332 in the Department of Natural Resources (Department) requesting approval to construct a permanent sheet pile structure at their diversion from the North Platte River in the Beerline channel located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 24, Township 19 North, Range 49 West of the 6th P.M. in Morrill County.

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

1. Petition MIP-2332 is GRANTED.
2. Beerline Canal Company is authorized to construct a permanent structure enabling them to control the water entering the Beerline Canal headgate from the Beerline channel on the North Platte River located in NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 24, Township 19 North, Range 49 West of the 6th P.M. in Morrill County.
3. The appropriator is not allowed to change the location of the diversion or divert more water than appropriated.
4. The appropriator is responsible for obtaining all necessary permits required prior to construction.
5. The appropriator must notify the Department when construction will begin and when construction is completed.
6. Within six months of the date of the completion of construction, the appropriator must file in the Department plans and specifications of the control structure.
