APPROVAL OF MAPS NUMBER 17605 AND 17606 FOR WATER APPROPRIATIONS HELD BY

CENTRAL NEBRASKA PUBLIC POWER AND IRRIGATION DISTRICT

WATER DIVISION 1-A

Background

1. The following water appropriations are held by the Central Nebraska Public Power and Irrigation District (CNPPID) authorizing them to divert water for irrigation from the Platte River into the Tri-County Canal at the headgate located in the W½ of Section 8, Township 13 North, Range 29 West of the 6th P.M. in Lincoln County.

2. On November 14, 1997, CNPPID filed Application M-2 in the Department of Natural Resources (Department) for a Map Transfer and map number 15584 under the provisions of Nebraska Revised Statutes Sections 46-2,120 to 46-2,125.
3. On January 5, 1999, the Department approved application M-2, but not map number 15584. CNPPID was instructed to file revised map pages corresponding to the findings and conclusions of the approval Order.
4. CNPPID and the Department worked on the revisions, and the final map is divided into two maps: one map depicting land irrigated by storage water; and the second map depicting land irrigated by naturally flowing water.
5. On January 15, 2010, CNPPID filed maps number 17605 and 17606 in the Department, depicting CNPPID's appropriations listed above for Map Transfer M-2, and incorporating all subsequent CNPPID "District Transfers" filed pursuant to Nebraska Revised Statutes Sections 46-2,127 to 46-2,129 and 46-261.


Order

1. Maps number 17605 and 17606 are APPROVED.
2. The land authorized to be irrigated (appurtenant land) under CNPPID's appropriations is listed on the Attachment (list of lands) and depicted on maps number 17605 and 17606, which are made a part of this Order.
3. All terms and conditions of surface water appropriations A-2355, A-3476, A-3620, A-3823, A-4656, A-5278, A-7716, A-9673, A-10280, A-10281, A-10282, A-17111 and A-17112 remain in effect, unless specifically changed by this Order.
