Plan of Dam Approval

This matter comes before the Director of the Department of Natural Resources (Department) pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. § 46-1652 (Supp. 2005) which generally requires anyone intending to construct a dam to file an application for approval of plans and specifications of a dam prior to beginning such construction.

Plan number P-16999 and associated specifications have been examined. The examination shows that:

1. The plan is for the construction of a dam subject to the Safety of Dams and Reservoirs Act. The dam is located in the NE¼ of Section 11, Township 11 North, Range 20 West of the 6th P.M. in Dawson County.
2. Kevin D. Gustafson, P.E., of the NRCS, Grand Island Field Office, 2550 North Diers, Suite L, Grand Island, Nebraska 68803-1214, prepared the drawings and specifications.
3. Bart Beattie, 44296 Road 767, Sumner, Nebraska 68878, owns the dam.
4. The drawings and specifications were examined by a Registered Professional Engineer of the Department and were found to be consistent with current standards.
5. Following consultation with the Nebraska Game and Parks Commission, the Department finds the project will have "No Effect" on any state listed threatened or endangered species.

The plan is hereby APPROVED subject to the following limitations, conditions and notices:

1. This approval will remain in effect for purposes of construction until November 1, 2008.
