ORDER OF CANCELLATION IN FULL OF WATER APPROPRIATION A-16685

WATER DIVISION 1-A

BACKGROUND

1. Records on file in the Department of Natural Resources (Department) show that surface water appropriation A-16685 is held by Logan C. and Anne Stuart Kinnison, and Mary C. Stuart.
2. Appropriation A-16685 has a priority date of July 12, 1988, and authorizes the use of water for irrigation of the 77.6 acres of land described below. The water may be diverted from Strever Creek at points of diversion located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 4, Township 9 North, Range 21 West of the 6<sup>th</sup> P.M. in Dawson County. The rate that water may be diverted shall not exceed one cubic foot per second (cfs) for every 70 acres irrigated at a maximum rate of 1.11 cfs.
