ORDER OF CANCELLATION IN FULL OF WATER APPROPRIATION A-186R T-217

WATER DIVISION 1-A

BACKGROUND

1. Records on file in the Department of Natural Resources (Department) show that surface water appropriation A-186R T-217 is held by George and Wilma Bott.
2. Appropriation A-186R T-217 has a priority date of October 22, 1895, and authorizes the use of water for irrigation of the 46.0 acres of land described below. The water may be diverted from Melbeta Creek via the Bott Canal headgate located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 24, Township 21 North, Range 54 West of the 6th P.M. in Scotts Bluff County. The rate that water may be diverted shall not exceed one cubic foot per second (cfs) for every 70 acres irrigated at a maximum rate of 0.66 cfs.


