ORDER GRANTING PERMIT TO TRANSFER GROUND WATER TO AN ADJOINING STATE

The Director of the Department of Natural Resources (Department) approves Application TA-31, submitted by Fern B. Gullett and Betty J. Young, for a permit to withdraw and transport ground water to Wyoming for irrigation use.

The terms and conditions of permit TA-31 are as follows:


1. Transfer permit TA-31 authorizes the Applicants withdraw ground water from well G-015400 and transfer a maximum of 33.5 acre-feet (10,916,009 gallons) per year.
2. The maximum daily withdrawal shall not exceed 440,640 gallons.
3. The Applicants may withdraw ground water from existing irrigation well G-015400, located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 16, Township 23 North, Range 58 West of the 6th P.M. in Scotts Bluff County, Nebraska, and transport the water for irrigation purposes on 33.5 acres located in the E $\frac{1}{2}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 15, Township 23 North, Range 60 West of the 6th P.M. in Goshen County, Wyoming.
4. The Applicants shall comply with all state and federal laws and the regulations of the North Platte Natural Resources District, including, but not limited to, the following:
 - a. Any replacement water well must be registered as required by Section 46-602(1) RSS.
 - b. The withdrawal and transfer must be in accordance with the provisions of any future integrated management plan adopted by the North Platte Natural Resources District.
5. The Applicants shall provide access to the property described herein at reasonable times for purposes of inspection by officials of the North Platte Natural Resources District or of the Department.
6. The Applicants shall notify the Department of the need for any abandonment or replacement of the permitted well and any changes in the place of use or nature of use, pursuant to the requirements of Section 46-602 RSS.
7. The Applicants shall install a flow meter on the well, and, by January 31 of each year, the Applicants shall file in the office of the Department a completed "Water Transfer Ground Water Well Report" on a form provided by the Department.

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THIS PERMIT MAY BE REVOKED OR MODIFIED BY THE DEPARTMENT FOR FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF THE PERMIT.
