ORDER DISMISSING APPLICATION FOR A PERMIT TO TRANSFER GROUND WATER FOR
MUNICIPAL AND RURAL DOMESTIC USE

The Director of the Department of Natural Resources (Department) dismisses Application MT-48, for a permit to transfer ground water for municipal and rural domestic use, submitted by the City of Humboldt, Nebraska.

Application MT-48 was filed by the City of Humboldt in conjunction with Application MT-47 to transfer ground water from two new wells constructed by the City for public water supply. Application MT-47 was filed to transfer ground water from two older wells constructed by the City of Humboldt for public water supply to the City's service area.

Upon review of the application documents, the Department determined that, given the nature and operation of the transfers proposed under each application, the two sets of wells and all ground water proposed to be withdrawn for public water supply should be combined in a single application.

The Applicant concurred with the Department's determination and, in a letter received October 21, 2014, requested that Application MT-48 be dismissed.

It is therefore ORDERED that Application MT-48 is DISMISSED.
