APPROVAL OF MAP 18649 FOR WATER APPROPRIATION A-19124

WATER DIVISION 2-A

BACKGROUND

1. On August 5, 2013, Lena J. Osentowski, on behalf of the Lena J. Osentowski Trust Dated January 31, 2001, filed in the Department of Natural Resources (Department) application A-19124 for a Permit to Appropriate Water.
2. On October 11, 2013, Lena J. Osentowski filed in the Department map number 18649 showing land proposed to be irrigated under application A-19124.

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

1. Map number 18649 is APPROVED.
2. The following land is authorized to be watered for domestic purposes (appurtenant land) under surface water appropriation A-19124 as depicted on map number 18649 which is made a part of this Order.



Section 30: NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ 2

3. Appropriation A-19124 has a priority date of August 5, 2013, and authorizes the appropriator the use of water for domestic purposes on the 2 acres of land described above. The water may be diverted from a tributary to Elm Creek at a point of diversion located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 30, Township 20 North, Range 13 West of the 6th P.M. in Valley County, as depicted on map number 18649. Water diverted shall not exceed the rate of 0.02 cfs (10 gallons per minute).
4. The appropriator is bound by all terms and conditions of the approval of application A-19124.
