APPROVAL OF MAP 19071 FOR WATER APPROPRIATION A-18515

WATER DIVISION 2-C

BACKGROUND

1. On May 29, 2007, Gerard Keating filed in the Department of Natural Resources (Department) application A-18515 for a Permit to Appropriate Water.
2. On October 23, 2014, Gerard Keating filed in the Department map number 19071 showing land proposed to be irrigated under application A-18515.

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

1. Map number 19071 is APPROVED.
2. The following land is authorized to be irrigated (appurtenant land) under surface water appropriation A-18515 as depicted on map number 19071 which is made a part of this Order.

3. Appropriation A-18515 has a priority date of May 29, 2007, and authorizes the appropriator the use of water for irrigation of the 109.0 acres of land described above. The water may be diverted from Big Sandy Creek at points of diversion located on both banks of the stream in the NW¹/₄SE¹/₄ of Section 12, Township 33 North, Range 14 West of the 6th P.M. in Holt County, as depicted on map number 19071. Water diverted shall not exceed the ratio of one cubic foot per second (cfs) for every 70 acres irrigated at a maximum combined rate of 1.56 cfs from both points of diversion (700 gallons per minute).

4. Water diverted shall not exceed the ratio of one cfs for every 70 acres irrigated nor the least amount of water necessary for the production of crops in the exercise of good husbandry. Therefore, in any year when less than the maximum permitted acres are being irrigated, the quantity of water diverted at any time may be restricted to 1/70 cfs for each permitted acre being irrigated that year. This appropriation of water under any circumstance shall be limited annually to 3 acre-feet per acre of land on which water is actually and beneficially applied; not to exceed the least amount of water necessary for the production of crops in the exercise of good husbandry.
5. The appropriator is bound by all terms and conditions of the approval of application A-18515.
