APPROVAL OF MAP 19074 FOR WATER APPROPRIATION A-17714

WATER DIVISION 2-F

Background

1. Records on file in the Department of Natural Resources (Department) show that surface water appropriation A-17714 is held by Kathleen A. and Ronald E. Weiss.
2. Appropriation A-17714 has a priority date of November 12, 1998, and authorizes the use of water for irrigation of four acres of land described below and on map 15631A, by Order dated January 30, 2002. The water may be diverted from Papillion Creek at a point of diversion located on the left bank of the stream in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 29, Township 14 North, Range 13 East of the 6th P.M. in Sarpy County. Water diverted shall not exceed the ratio of one cubic foot per second (cfs) for every 70 acres irrigated at a maximum rate of 0.06 cfs (127 gallons per minute).

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3. The Department has received information that hand drawn map number 15631A inaccurately represented the project.
4. The Department's mapping staff, using current mapping technology, prepared map number 19074 which more accurately depicts the four acres of land authorized for irrigation under appropriation A-17714. There is no change to the number of acres per quarter quarter irrigated.
5. On October 30, 2014, Alan Weiss, on behalf of Kathleen A. and Ronald E. Weiss, filed map number 19074 showing land irrigated under application A-17714.

Order

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

1. Map number 15631A, approved January 30, 2002, is set aside.
2. Map number 19074 which shows the land irrigated under appropriation A-17714 is APPROVED.

3. The following land is authorized to be irrigated (appurtenant land) under surface water appropriation A-17714 as depicted on map number 19074 which is made a part of this Order.



4. Appropriation A-17714 has a priority date of November 12, 1998, and authorizes the appropriator the use of water for irrigation of the four acres of land described above. The water may be diverted from Papillion Creek at a point of diversion located on the left bank of the stream in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 29, Township 14 North, Range 13 East of the 6th P.M. in Sarpy County as depicted on map number 19074. Water diverted shall not exceed the ratio of one cubic foot per second (cfs) for every 70 acres irrigated at a maximum rate of 0.06 cfs (27 gallons per minute).
5. All other terms and conditions of appropriation A-17714 remain in FULL FORCE AND AFFECT.
