ORDER OF DISMISSAL OF APPLICATION A-19092

FOR A PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE WATER

WATER DIVISION 2-F

BACKGROUND


1. On June 10, 2013, David T. Davidson, on behalf of Ed Olson, filed in the Department of Natural Resources (Department) application A-19092 for a permit to appropriate water from a tributary to Bazile Creek for domestic purposes. The proposed point of diversion would be located in Section 36, Township 31 North, Range 05 West of the 6th P.M. in Knox County.
2. On July 10, 2015, the Department returned application A-19092 for corrections and requested additional information.
3. On July 13, 2015, Jeffie Martin, on behalf of David T. Davidson, received notification of the deficiencies of application A-19092.
4. *Nebraska Revised Statutes* § 46-233 (3) provides that an applicant shall file the corrected application within ninety days of receipt of such notification.
5. Application A-19092 was not submitted to the Department within ninety days of receipt of notification. Therefore, application A-19092 should be dismissed.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED application A-19092 is DISMISSED.
