ORDER OF DISMISSAL OF APPLICATION A-19282  
FOR A PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE WATER

WATER DIVISION 2-A

BACKGROUND

1. On August 15, 2014, David and Barbara J. Pomplun filed in the Department of Natural Resources (Department) application A-19282 for a permit to appropriate water from the South Loup River to maintain the water level in a pond. The project is located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 10, Township 14 North, Range 21 West of the 6<sup>th</sup> P.M. in Custer County.
2. The diversion and use of water under application A-19282 does not meet the criteria for a natural flow permit.
3. On November 20, 2014, David and Barbara J. Pomplun filed in the Department application A-19310 for a permit to impound water in lieu of A-19282; therefore, A-19282 should be dismissed.
