APPROVAL OF APPLICATION A-19298

WATER DIVISION 2-F

BACKGROUND

1. On September 4, 2014, David Zavadil, on behalf of Clinton J. Zavadil, filed in the Department of Natural Resources (Department) application A-19298 for a Permit to Appropriate Water.
2. On February 12, 2015, David Zavadil filed in the Department map number 19067 showing land proposed to be irrigated under application A-19298.

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that application A-19298 is APPROVED subject to the following limitations and conditions:

1. The source of water is Lewis and Clark Lake.
2. The water shall be used for domestic purposes such as watering the lawn, trees, or garden for family use.
3. The priority date is September 4, 2014.
4. The appropriator must comply with all relevant statutes. The statutes include, but are not limited to, the following:
 - A. Notify the Department of any change in ownership or address.
 - B. Notify the Department of the name and address of the person responsible for the use of the water appropriation (this may include farm managers, tenants, or relatives that actually apply the water to the approved use).
 - C. Obtain approval from the Department prior to taking any action that changes the location of the point of diversion, the location of the place of use, the type of use, or the type of appropriation.
5. The appropriator must comply with the following deadlines:
 - A. Written proof that the United States Army Corps of Engineers grants the appropriator the right to remove water from Lewis and Clark Lake must be filed by six months past the signing date of this approval. No rights shall be deemed to have been acquired until the provisions of this paragraph have been complied with, and a failure to do so shall cause a forfeiture of the appropriation and all rights thereof.

- B. Construction of the diversion works must begin within twelve months of the signing date of this application approval. The appropriator must proceed diligently with the construction unless interrupted by some unavoidable and natural cause.
- C. Construction of the project must be completed by two years past the signing date of this application approval.
- D. The appropriation is not considered perfected until water has been beneficially applied for the purpose stated in this approval. The water appropriated under A-19298 must be beneficially used by September 1, 2017.
- E. After September 1, 2017, a field investigation will be conducted to determine the acres irrigated, after which an order of cancellation will be issued for any unused portions of appropriation A-19298.


ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Failure to comply with all laws and regulations pertaining to surface water appropriations, any orders issued by the Director of the Department of Natural Resources, or the provisions of this Approval may result in the cancellation of the appropriation, temporary closing of the appropriation, administrative penalty, criminal prosecution, or any combination thereof.

Nebraska law provides that failure to use a portion or all of a perfected appropriation for more than five consecutive years may result in cancellation of the appropriation.

The applicant and any person with sufficient legal interest who has been or may be substantially affected by this order may request a contested case hearing in accordance with the *Neb. Admin. Procedures Act* §§ 84-901 et. seq. RRS and the Department's *Rules of Practice and Procedure Title 454 Admin. Code Chapter 7*. The request must be received by the Department at its Lincoln office (Nebraska State Office Building, 4th Floor, 301 Centennial Mall South, P.O. Box 94676, Lincoln, Nebraska 68509-4676) within 30 days of the date of the order and be accompanied by a filing fee of \$10.
