APPROVAL OF MAP 19067 FOR WATER APPROPRIATION A-19298

BACKGROUND

1. On September 4, 2014, David Zavadil, on behalf of Clinton J. Zavadil, filed in the Department of Natural Resources (Department) application A-19298 for a Permit to Appropriate Water.
2. On February 12, 2015, David Zavadil filed in the Department map number 19067 showing land proposed to be irrigated under application A-19298.

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

1. Map number 19067 is APPROVED.
2. The following is a description of all the land which is authorized to be irrigated (appurtenant land) under surface water appropriation A-19298 as depicted on map number 19067:


Township 33 North, Range 3 West of the
6th P.M. in Knox County Acres

Section 15: Lot 4 0.8

3. Appropriation A-19298 has a priority date of September 4, 2014, and authorizes the appropriator the use of water for domestic purposes on the 0.8 acre of land described above. The water may be diverted from Lewis and Clark Lake at a point of diversion located in Section 15, Township 33 North, Range 3 West of the 6th P.M. in Knox County, as depicted on map number 19067, with the permission from the United States Army Corps of Engineers to divert water for irrigation from this reservoir.
4. The appropriator is bound by all terms and conditions of the approval of application A-19298.
