ORDER OF CANCELLATION IN FULL OF WATER APPROPRIATION A-19298

WATER DIVISION 2-F

BACKGROUND

1. Records on file in the Department of Natural Resources (Department) show that surface water appropriation A-19298 is held by Clinton J. Zavadil.
2. Appropriation A-19298 was approved on February 25, 2015, with a priority date of September 4, 2014, and authorizes the use of water for domestic purposes on the 0.8 acre of land described below. The water may be diverted from Lewis and Clark Lake at a point of diversion located in Section 15, Township 33 North, Range 03 West of the 6th P.M. in Knox County with permission from the United States Army Corps of Engineers.

Section 15: Lot 04 0.8


3. Within six months of the signing date of approval of application A-19298, the appropriator was to file written proof that the United States Army Corps of Engineers grants the appropriator the right to remove water from Lewis and Clark Lake. That six month period ended on August 25, 2015.
4. The appropriator failed to comply with the abovementioned condition of appropriation A-19298. Therefore, appropriation A-19298 should be cancelled.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED appropriation A-19298 is CANCELLED.
