ORDER OF CANCELLATION IN FULL OF WATER APPROPRIATION A-12144

WATER DIVISION 2-A

BACKGROUND

1. Records on file in the Department of Natural Resources (Department) show that surface water appropriation A-12144 is held by James A. and Carol J. Homolka.
2. Appropriation A-12144 has a priority date of January 20, 1971, and authorizes the use of water for irrigation of the 12.11 acres of land described below. The water may be diverted from Beaver Creek at a point of diversion located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 32, Township 18 North, Range 4 West of the 6th P.M. in Nance County. Water diverted shall not exceed the ratio of one cubic foot per second (cfs) for every 70 acres irrigated at a maximum rate of 0.17 cfs.

3. On April 27, 2015, James A. and Carol J. Homolka filed a Relinquishment of Water Appropriation, REL-5396, in the office of the Department relinquishing the right to divert water under appropriation A-12144 for use upon the land described above.
