APPROVAL OF MAP 19019 FOR WATER APPROPRIATION A-19206

WATER DIVISION 1-D

BACKGROUND

1. On March 10, 2014, Rodney W. Skleba filed in the Department of Natural Resources (Department) application A-19206 for a Permit to Appropriate Water.
2. On August 27, 2014, Rodney W. Skleba filed in the Department map number 19019 showing land proposed to be irrigated under application A-19206.

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

1. Map number 19019 is APPROVED.
2. The following land is authorized to be irrigated (appurtenant land) under surface water appropriation A-19206 as depicted on map number 19019 which is made a part of this Order.

3. Appropriation A-19206 has a priority date of March 10, 2014, and authorizes the appropriator the use of water for irrigation of the 18.0 acres of land described above. The water may be diverted from the Big Blue River at a point of diversion located on the left bank of the stream in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 26, Township 4 North, Range 7 East of the 6th P.M. in Saline County, as depicted on map number 19019. Water diverted shall not exceed the ratio of one cubic foot per second (cfs) for every 140 acres irrigated at a maximum rate of 0.13 cfs from all points of diversion (58 gallons per minute).
4. Water diverted shall not exceed the ratio of one cfs for every 140 acres irrigated nor the least amount of water necessary for the production of crops in the exercise of good husbandry. Therefore, in any year when less than the maximum permitted acres are being irrigated, the quantity of water diverted at any time may be restricted to 140 cfs for each permitted acre being irrigated that year. This appropriation of water under any circumstance shall be limited annually to 3 acre-feet per acre of land on which water is actually and beneficially applied; not to exceed the least amount of water necessary for the production of crops in the exercise of good husbandry.
5. The appropriator is bound by all terms and conditions of the approval of application A-19206.
