APPROVAL OF MAP 18903 FOR WATER APPROPRIATION A-19231

WATER DIVISION 1-C

BACKGROUND

1. On April 11, 2014, Chad G. and Becky S. Ortmeier filed in the Department of Natural Resources (Department) application A-19231 for a Permit to Appropriate Water.
2. On September 30, 2014, Chad G. Ortmeier filed in the Department map number 18903 showing land proposed to be irrigated under application A-19231.

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

1. Map number 18903 is APPROVED.
2. The following land is authorized to be irrigated (appurtenant land) under surface water appropriation A-19231 as depicted on map number 18903 which is made a part of this Order.

3. Appropriation A-19231 has a priority date of April 11, 2014, and authorizes the appropriator the use of water for irrigation of the 34.6 acres of land described above. The water may be diverted from the Little Blue River at a point of diversion located on the right bank of the stream in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 12, Township 4 North, Range 7 West of the 6th P.M. in Nuckolls County, as depicted on map number 18903. Water diverted shall not exceed the ratio of one cubic foot per second (cfs) for every 70 acres irrigated at a maximum rate of 0.49 cfs (220 gallons per minute).

4. Water diverted shall not exceed the ratio of one cfs for every 70 acres irrigated nor the least amount of water necessary for the production of crops in the exercise of good husbandry. Therefore, in any year when less than the maximum permitted acres are being irrigated, the quantity of water diverted at any time may be restricted to 1/70 cfs for each permitted acre being irrigated that year. This appropriation of water under any circumstance shall be limited annually to 3 acre-feet per acre of land on which water is actually and beneficially applied; not to exceed the least amount of water necessary for the production of crops in the exercise of good husbandry.
