APPROVAL OF MAP 19013 FOR WATER APPROPRIATION A-19263

WATER DIVISION 1-D

BACKGROUND

1. On June 4, 2014, Alfred Daubendiek, Jr., filed in the Department of Natural Resources (Department) application A-19263 for a Permit to Appropriate Water.
2. On August 5, 2014, Alfred Daubendiek, Jr., filed map number 19013 showing the land proposed to be irrigated under A-19263.

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

1. Map number 19013 is APPROVED.
2. The following is a description of all the land which is authorized to be irrigated (appurtenant land) under surface water appropriation A-19263 as depicted on map number 19013:

Township 3 North, Range 7 East of the 6 th P.M. in Gage County	Acres
Section 34: NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$	29.3
NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$	34.2
SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$	<u>3.4</u>
TOTAL	66.9

3. Appropriation A-19263 authorizes the appropriator the use of 33.2 acre-feet annually from Daubendiek Reservoir Number 3 (storage appropriations A-19258 and A-19262) from a pump site located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 34, Township 3 North, Range 7 East of the 6th P.M. in Gage County, as depicted on map number 19013.
4. Appropriation A-19263 provides supplemental water to irrigate land under surface water appropriations A-16742 and A-19259 held by Alfred Daubendiek, Jr.

5. The appropriator is bound by all terms and conditions of the approval of application A-19263.
