APPROVAL OF APPLICATION A-19307,  
PETITION FOR A WAIVER OF OUTLET WORKS DWV-5244  
AND PLAN OF RESERVOIR 19116

WATER DIVISION 1-F

BACKGROUND

1. On November 17, 2014, Stephen A. and Geri E. Kean filed in the Department of Natural Resources (Department) application A-19307 for a permit to impound water.
2. On November 21, 2014, Stephen A. and Geri E. Kean filed in the Department petition DWV-5244 for a waiver of the requirement of outlet works.
3. On December 24, 2014, Andrew Q. Rieschick, P.E., on behalf of Stephen A. and Geri E. Kean, filed in the Department plan of reservoir 19116 for application A-19307.

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED Application A-19307, Petition DWV-5244 and plan of reservoir 19116 are APPROVED subject to the following limitations and conditions:

1. The source of water is the Bradley Branch.
2. The priority date is November 17, 2014.
3. The water to be stored under this appropriation is for the purpose of providing water for an irrigation project.
4. The amount of water that may be diverted shall not exceed 33.3 acre-feet per year to be stored in Kean Pond 1. Kean Dam will be located in the E $\frac{1}{2}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 14, Township 2 North, Range 14 East of the 6<sup>th</sup> P.M. in Richardson County.


5. *Nebraska Revised Statutes* § 46-241(5) states in part, "The owner or possessor of a reservoir or intentional underground water storage facility does not have the right to store water in such reservoir or facility during the time that such water is required downstream in ditches for direct irrigation or for any reservoir or facility holding a senior right. Every person who owns, controls, or operates a reservoir or intentional underground water storage facility, except political subdivisions of this state, shall be required to pass ... a portion of the measured inflows to furnish water for livestock ... ."
6. The owner or possessor of the reservoir storing water pursuant to A-19307 shall have structural controls in place or other mechanical means to immediately release a portion of the measured inflows in such amounts and at such times if so ordered by the Department.
7. A continuous recording device approved by the Department to monitor reservoir levels may be required if so ordered by the Department.
8. A waiver of the requirement of outlet works, by petition DWV-5244, has been granted. This waiver does not relieve the owner from the responsibility to pass a portion of the reservoir inflow by some method for downstream appropriators should there be a need for water administration; or if water should be required for livestock needs, unless the appropriator is a political subdivision. The Department may rescind the waiver and require installation of appropriate outlet works at a later date if it is determined that the responsibility to pass inflows is not being met or cannot be met by another method.
9. The appropriator must comply with all relevant statutes. This includes, but is not limited to, the following:
  - A. Notify the Department of any change in ownership or address.
  - B. Receive approval prior to taking any action that changes the storage capacity of this reservoir, plan of reservoir 19116, or the type of appropriation.
  - C. Assume liability for all damages due to leakage, overflow or structural failure of the structure.
  - D. Release a portion of the reservoir inflows for livestock where required, unless appropriator is a political subdivision.
10. The appropriator must comply with the following deadlines:
  - A. Construction of the structure must begin within twelve months of the signing date of this application approval. The appropriator must proceed diligently with the construction unless interrupted by some unavoidable and natural cause.
  - B. November 1, 2016 is the date construction of the structure must be completed.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Failure to comply with all laws and regulations pertaining to surface water appropriations and any orders issued by the Director of the Department of Natural Resources may result in the cancellation of the appropriation, temporary closing of the appropriation, administrative penalty, criminal prosecution, or any combination thereof.

The applicant and any person with sufficient legal interest who has been or may be substantially affected by this approval may request a contested case hearing in accordance with the *Neb. Admin. Procedures Act* §§ 84-901 et. seq. RRS and the Department's *Rules of Practice and Procedure Title 454 Admin. Code Chapter 7*. The request must be received by the Department at its Lincoln office (Nebraska State Office Building, 4<sup>th</sup> Floor, 301 Centennial Mall South, P.O. Box 94676, Lincoln, Nebraska 68509-4676) within 30 days of the date of the Approval and be accompanied by a filing fee of \$10.
