ORDER OF CANCELLATION IN FULL OF WATER APPROPRIATION A-18799R

WATER DIVISION 1-D

BACKGROUND

1. Records on file in the Department of Natural Resources (Department) show that surface water appropriation A-18799R is held by Gary D. and Sharon K. Rupprecht.
2. Appropriation A-18799R, with a priority date of August 26, 2011, authorizes the use of water for irrigation of the 152.2 acres of land described below. The water may be diverted from Big Indian Creek at points of diversion located on the right bank of the stream in the NW¹/₄NW¹/₄ and the SE¹/₄NW¹/₄ of Section 19, Township 1 North, Range 6 East of the 6th P.M. in Gage County. Water diverted shall not exceed the ratio of one cubic foot per second (cfs) for every 70 acres irrigated at a maximum combined rate of 2.17 cfs from all points of diversion.

3. The approval of appropriation A-18799R was conditional upon the irrigation of the above land by September 1, 2014.
4. Department personnel performed a field investigation and determined the land approved for irrigation under appropriation A-18799R had not been irrigated by September 1, 2014.
5. *Nebraska Revised Statutes* § 46-229.02(7) provides for the cancellation of unused portions of surface water appropriations.

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED appropriation A-18799R is CANCELLED.
