APPROVAL OF EXPEDITED TRANSFER EXT-5615 FOR WATER APPROPRIATION A-18194
AND MAP NUMBER 19513

WATER DIVISION 2-A

BACKGROUND

1. Records on file in the Department of Natural Resources (Department) show that surface water appropriation A-18194 is held by Clark T. Pedersen.
2. Appropriation A-18194 has a priority date of October 7, 2003, and authorizes the use of water for irrigation of the 63.0 acres of land described below. The water may be diverted from the Middle Loup River at a point of diversion located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 28, Township 13 North, Range 12 West of the 6th P.M. in Howard County. Water diverted shall not exceed the ratio of one cubic foot per second (cfs) for every 234 acres irrigated at a maximum rate of 0.27 cfs.

3. Appropriation A-18194 provides additional water to land approved for irrigation under appropriation A-15246.
4. On June 6, 2016, Clark T. Pedersen filed application EXT-5615 for a permit for an expedited transfer of the location of use for land authorized to be irrigated by appropriation A-18194 and map number 19513 showing the land proposed to be irrigated under appropriation A-18194 through transfer EXT-5615.

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

1. Application EXT-5615 for a permit for an expedited transfer of the location of use and map number 19513 are APPROVED.

2. Appropriation A-18194 through transfer EXT-5615 authorizes the use of water to irrigate 63.0 acres of land described below and depicted on map number 19513, which is made a part of this Order. The water may be diverted from the Middle Loup River at a point of diversion located on the left bank of the stream in the NW¹/₄SW¹/₄ of Section 28, Township 13 North, Range 12 West of the 6th P.M. in Howard County, as depicted on map number 19513. Water diverted shall not exceed the ratio of one cfs for every 234 acres irrigated at a maximum rate of 0.27 cfs (121 gallons per minute). The total volume may not exceed 0.9 acre-feet per irrigated acre per year; not to exceed the least amount of water necessary for the production of crops in the exercise of good husbandry.

3. Appropriation A-18194 through EXT-5615 provides additional water to land approved for irrigation under appropriation A-15246 through EXT-5614.
4. All terms and conditions of appropriation A-18194 remain in effect unless specifically changed by this Order.
5. The appropriator must comply with all relevant statutes. These relevant statutory requirements include, but are not limited to, the following:
 - A. Notify the Department of any change in ownership or address.
 - B. Notify the Department of the name and address of the person responsible for the use of the water appropriation (this may include farm managers, tenants, or relatives that actually apply the water to the approved use).
 - C. Obtain approval from the Department prior to taking any action that changes the location of the point of diversion, the location of the place of use, the type of use, or the type of appropriation.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Failure to comply with all laws and regulations pertaining to surface water appropriations, any orders issued by the Director of the Department of Natural Resources, or the provisions of this Approval may cause cancellation of part or all of this appropriation, temporary closing of the appropriation, administrative penalty, criminal prosecution, or any combination thereof.

Nebraska law provides that failure to use a portion or all of a perfected appropriation for more than five consecutive years may result in cancellation of the appropriation.

This appropriation is not a guarantee that water will be available. Nebraska law gives priority to senior appropriations. This appropriation may be closed if there is insufficient water to satisfy senior appropriations.
