ORDER OF DISMISSAL OF APPLICATION A-18596

FOR A PERMIT TO IMPOUND WATER AND

DISMISSAL OF APPLICATION FOR APPROVAL OF PLANS FOR DAMS 17229

WATER DIVISION 2-B

BACKGROUND

1. On May 16, 2008, Joseph B., Scott, Tim, Doug and Dan Anderson filed in the Department of Natural Resources (Department) application A-18596 for a permit to impound water from a tributary to Dry Creek for the purpose of flood control, fish and wildlife and recreation located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 14, Township 21 North, Range 07 East of the 6th P.M. in Cuming County.
2. On August 17, 2016, Joseph B. Anderson, filed correspondence in the Department indicating that the proposed project under application A-18596 will not be moving forward because the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers did not grant the required permit.
3. Therefore, application A-18596 and the application of approval of plans for dams 17229 should be dismissed.

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED application A-18596 for a permit to appropriate water and application 17229 for approval of plans for dams are DISMISSED.
