APPROVAL OF EXPEDITED TRANSFER EXT-5604 FOR WATER APPROPRIATION A-2275A

AND MAP NUMBER 19506

WATER DIVISION 2-C

BACKGROUND

1. Records on file in the Department of Natural Resources (Department) show that surface water appropriation A-2275A is held by Skavdahl Bros., Inc.
2. A review of the Department's records indicates that a scrivener's error was made on the land listing on the Order dated February 22, 2005. There are **33.0 acres** of land authorized for irrigation in the **SW¹/₄SW¹/₄** and **17.0 acres** in the **SE¹/₄SW¹/₄** of Section 33, Township 29 North, Range 54 West of the 6th P.M. in Sioux County rather than 33.0 acres in the SE¹/₄SW¹/₄ and 17.0 acres in the SW¹/₄SW¹/₄ of said legal description.
3. Appropriation A-2275A has a priority date of July 11, 1932, and authorizes the use of water for irrigation of the 66.0 acres of land described below. The water may be diverted from the Niobrara River via the headgate of the Harris-Neece Canal located in the NW¹/₄SE¹/₄ of Section 03, Township 28 North, Range 55 West of the 6th P.M. in Sioux County. Water diverted shall not exceed the ratio of one cubic foot per second (cfs) for every 70 acres irrigated at a maximum rate of 0.95 cfs.

4. On June 27, 2016, Charles H. Skavdahl, on behalf of Skavdahl Bros., Inc., filed application EXT-5604 for a permit for an expedited transfer of the location of use for a portion of land authorized to be irrigated by appropriation A-2275A and map number 19506 showing that portion of land proposed to be irrigated under appropriation A-2275A through transfer EXT-5604.

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

1. Application EXT-5604 for a permit for an expedited transfer of the location of use and map number 19506 are APPROVED.

2. Transfer EXT-5604 authorizes the use of water to irrigate the 48.6 acres of land described below and depicted on map number 19506, which is made a part of this Order.

3. Appropriation A-2275A, through transfer EXT-5604, authorizes the use of water to irrigate the 66.0 acres of land described below and depicted on map number 19594, which is made a part of this Order.

4. The water may be diverted from the Niobrara River via the headgate of the Harris-Neece Canal located in the NW¹/₄SE¹/₄ of Section 03, Township 28 North, Range 55 West of the 6th P.M. in Sioux County, as depicted on map number 19594. Water diverted shall not exceed the ratio of one cfs for every 70 acres irrigated at a maximum rate of 0.95 cfs (426 gallons per minute). The total volume may not exceed 3 acre-feet per irrigated acre per year; not to exceed the least amount of water necessary for the production of crops in the exercise of good husbandry.
5. All terms and conditions of appropriation A-2275 and A-2275A remain in effect unless specifically changed by this Order.

6. The appropriator must comply with all relevant statutes. These relevant statutory requirements include, but are not limited to, the following:
 - A. Notify the Department of any change in ownership or address.
 - B. Notify the Department of the name and address of the person responsible for the use of the water appropriation (this may include farm managers, tenants, or relatives that actually apply the water to the approved use).
 - C. Obtain approval from the Department prior to taking any action that changes the location of the point of diversion, the location of the place of use, the type of use, or the type of appropriation.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION


Failure to comply with all laws and regulations pertaining to surface water appropriations, any orders issued by the Director of the Department of Natural Resources, or the provisions of this Approval may cause cancellation of part or all of this appropriation, temporary closing of the appropriation, administrative penalty, criminal prosecution, or any combination thereof.

Nebraska law provides that failure to use an appropriation for more than five consecutive years may result in cancellation of the appropriation.

This appropriation is not a guarantee that water will be available. Nebraska law gives priority to senior appropriations. This appropriation may be closed if there is insufficient water to satisfy senior appropriations.

Box 94676, Lincoln, Nebraska 68509-4676) within 30 days of the date of the order and be accompanied by a filing fee of \$10.
