ORDER OF CANCELLATION IN FULL OF WATER APPROPRIATION A-18148

WATER DIVISION 2-C

Background

1. Records on file in the Department of Natural Resources (Department) show that surface water appropriation A-18148 is held by Charles M. Lemp.
2. Appropriation A-18148, with a priority date of March 3, 2003, authorizes the use of water for irrigation of the 23 acres of land described below. The water may be diverted from Long Pine Creek at a point of diversion located on the east bank of the stream in the SW¹/₄NW¹/₄ of Section 20, Township 30 North, Range 20 West of the 6th P.M. in Brown County. The rate that water may be diverted shall not exceed one cubic foot per second (cfs) for every 70 acres irrigated at a maximum rate of 0.33 cfs.


3. The approval of appropriation A-18148 was conditional upon the irrigation of the above land by September 1, 2005.
4. Department personnel performed a field investigation and determined the land approved for irrigation under appropriation A-18148 had not been irrigated by September 1, 2005.
5. Nebraska Revised Statutes Section 46-229.02(7) provides for the cancellation of unused portions of surface water appropriations.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED appropriation A-18148 is CANCELLED.
