APPROVAL OF MAP 17799 FOR WATER APPROPRIATION A-18750

WATER DIVISION 1-D

BACKGROUND

1. On February 23, 2011, Mark and Connie Strouf filed in the Department of Natural Resources (Department) application A-18750 for a Permit to Appropriate Water.
2. On March 4, 2011, Mark Strouf filed map number 17799 showing land proposed to be irrigated under application A-18750.

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

1. Map number 17799 is APPROVED.
2. The following land is authorized to be irrigated (appurtenant land) under surface water appropriation A-18750 as depicted on map number 17799 which is made a part of this Order.

3. Appropriation A-18750 authorizes the appropriator the use of water for irrigation of the 15.7 acres of land described above. The water may be diverted from Turkey Creek at points of diversion in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 4, Township 5 North, Range 4 East of the 6<sup>th</sup> P.M. in Saline County, at a combined maximum rate of 0.22 cubic foot per second (cfs) (99 gallons per minute).
4. The rate that water may be diverted shall not exceed one cfs for every 70 acres irrigated nor the least amount of water necessary for the production of crops in the exercise of good husbandry. Therefore, in any year when less than the maximum permitted acres are being irrigated, the quantity of water diverted at any time may be restricted to 1/70 cfs for each permitted acre being irrigated that year.

5. The appropriator is bound by all terms and conditions of the approval of application A-18750.
