APPROVAL OF MAP 18671 FOR WATER APPROPRIATION A-19139

WATER DIVISION 1-F

BACKGROUND

1. On September 6, 2013, Maxine Hillman, on behalf of the Dale Hillman Trust, filed in the Department of Natural Resources (Department) application A-19139 for a Permit to Appropriate Water.
2. On October 15, 2013, Daniel L. Hillman, on behalf of the Dale Hillman Trust, filed in the Department map number 18671 showing land proposed to be irrigated under application A-19139.

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

1. Map number 18671 is APPROVED.
2. The following land is authorized to be irrigated (appurtenant land) under surface water appropriation A-19139 as depicted on map number 18671 which is made a part of this Order.

3. Appropriation A-19139 has a priority date of September 6, 2013, and authorizes the appropriator the use of water for irrigation of the 170.5 acres of land described above. The water may be diverted from a tributary to the Little Nemaha River at points of diversion located on both banks of the stream in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$  and the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 5, Township 7 North, Range 12 East of the 6<sup>th</sup> P.M. in Otoe County. Water diverted shall not exceed the ratio of one cubic foot per second (cfs) for every 70 acres irrigated at a maximum combined rate of 2.44 cfs from all points of diversion (1,095 gallons per minute).

4. Water diverted shall not exceed the ratio of one cfs for every 70 acres irrigated nor the least amount of water necessary for the production of crops in the exercise of good husbandry. Therefore, in any year when less than the maximum permitted acres are being irrigated, the quantity of water diverted at any time may be restricted to 1/70 cfs for each permitted acre being irrigated that year. This appropriation of water under any circumstance shall be limited annually to 3 acre-feet per acre of land on which water is actually and beneficially applied.
5. The appropriator is bound by all terms and conditions of the approval of application A-19139.
