ORDER OF CANCELLATION IN FULL OF WATER APPROPRIATION A-2112

WATER DIVISION 2-C

Background

1. Records on file in the Department of Natural Resources (Department) show that surface water appropriation A-2112 is held by Ernest A. and Betty J. Hasch.
2. Appropriation A-2112 has a priority date of November 14, 1929, and authorizes the use of water for irrigation of the 0.924 acres of land described below. The water may be diverted from Sand Creek via the Peacock Canal headgate located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 35, in Township 32 North, Range 18 West of the 6<sup>th</sup> P.M. in Rock County. The rate that water may be diverted shall not exceed 0.02 cubic foot per second (cfs).

Section 35: NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$  0.924


3. The Department has received information concerning the use of surface water appropriation A-2112 that indicates the appropriation has not been used for its required purpose for more than 5 consecutive years.
4. On April 22, 2010, the Department issued a Notice of Preliminary Determination of Nonuse of appropriation A-2112. The notice was delivered by certified mail to Ernest A. and Betty J. Hasch, 607 Sunrise Circle, PO Box 403, Bassett, Nebraska 68714.
5. No contest of the Preliminary Determination of Nonuse was received in the Department.
6. The Department has determined that appropriation A-2112 has not been used for its required purpose for more than five consecutive years.
7. Nebraska Revised Statutes Section 46-229.02 provides that an appropriation not used for a beneficial purpose for more than five consecutive years may be cancelled.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED appropriation A-2112 is CANCELLED.
