ORDER OF CANCELLATION IN FULL OF WATER APPROPRIATION A-10804

WATER DIVISION 2-C

BACKGROUND

1. Records on file in the Department of Natural Resources (Department) show that surface water appropriation A-10804 is held by Robert D. and Mary M. Pischel and Reginold A. and Janice E. Pischel.
2. Appropriation A-10804 has a priority date of March 16, 1966, and authorizes the use of water for irrigation of the 75 acres of land described below. The water may be diverted from the Niobrara River at a point of diversion located on the left bank of the stream in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 16, Township 32 North, Range 8 West of the 6<sup>th</sup> P.M. in Knox County. The rate that water may be diverted shall not exceed one cubic foot per second (cfs) for every 70 acres irrigated at a maximum rate of 1.07 cfs.


