ORDER OF CANCELLATION IN FULL OF WATER APPROPRIATION A-18719

WATER DIVISION 1-D

BACKGROUND

1. Records on file in the Department of Natural Resources (Department) show that surface water appropriation A-18719 is held by Michael Parde.
2. Appropriation A-18719 has a priority date of September 7, 2010, and authorizes the use of water for irrigation of the 18.7 acres of land described below. The water may be diverted from Parde Irrigation Pond at a point of diversion located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 19, Township 1 North, Range 7 East of the 6th P.M. in Gage County. The amount of water diverted shall not exceed 6.9 acre-feet per year.

3. On September 11, 2012, Michael Parde filed a Relinquishment of Water Appropriation, REL-2406, in the office of the Department relinquishing the right to divert water under appropriation A-18719 for use upon the land described above.
