APPROVAL OF APPLICATION A-18730

WATER DIVISION 1-D

BACKGROUND

1. On December 10, 2010, Robbie Hofeling filed in the Department of Natural Resources (Department) application A-18730 for a permit to impound water, plan P-17753 and specifications according to *Title 457 Neb. Admin. Code Chapter 11*.
2. Construction has been completed.

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED Application A-18730 and plan P-17753 are APPROVED subject to the following limitations and conditions:


1. The source of water is a tributary to Wildcat Creek.
2. The priority date is December 10, 2010.
3. The amount of water that may be diverted shall not exceed 16.8 acre-feet per year to be stored in Hofeling Pond Number 3. Hofeling Dam Number 3 is located in the NE¹/₄ of Section 33, Township 3 North, Range 8 East of the 6th P.M. in Gage County.
4. The appropriator must comply with all relevant statutes. This includes, but is not limited to, the following:
 - A. Notify the Department of any change in ownership or address.
 - B. Receive approval prior to taking any action that changes the storage capacity of this reservoir, plan P-17753, or the type of appropriation.
 - C. Assume liability for all damages due to leakage, overflow or structural failure of the structure.
 - D. Release a portion of the reservoir inflows for livestock where required, unless appropriator is a political subdivision.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Failure to comply with all laws and regulations pertaining to surface water appropriations and any orders issued by the Director of the Department of Natural Resources may result in the cancellation of the appropriation, temporary closing of the appropriation, administrative penalty, criminal prosecution, or any combination thereof.

The applicant and any person with sufficient legal interest who has been or may be substantially affected by this approval may request a contested case hearing in accordance with the *Neb. Admin. Procedures Act* §§ 84-901 et. seq. RRS and the Department's *Rules of Practice and Procedure 454 Neb. Admin. Code Chapter 7*. The request must be received by the Department at its Lincoln office (4th Floor, Nebraska State Office Building, 301 Centennial Mall South, P.O. Box 94676, Lincoln, Nebraska 68509-4676) within 30 days of the date of the Approval and be accompanied by a filing fee of \$10.
