APPROVAL OF APPLICATION A-18888

WATER DIVISION 2-C

BACKGROUND

1. On March 8, 2012, Dwaine A. Pavelka, on behalf of Delores M. Pavelka, landowner, filed in the Department of Natural Resources (Department) application A-18888 for a permit to appropriate water.
2. On March 8, 2012, Delores M. Pavelka filed in the Department map number 18144 showing land proposed to be irrigated under application A-18888.

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that application A-18888 is APPROVED subject to the following limitations and conditions:

1. The source of water is Pavelka Reservoir No. 1, permitted under storage appropriation A-18887.
2. A map of reservoir and specifications according to *Department of Natural Resources Rules of Practice and Procedure, Title 457 Neb. Admin. Code Chapter 11* must be filed within six months of the signing date of application A-18887. No rights shall be deemed to have been acquired until the provisions of this paragraph have been complied with, and a failure to do so shall cause a forfeiture of storage appropriation A-18887 and storage use appropriation A-18888 and all rights thereof.
3. The water shall be used for the purpose of irrigation.
4. The priority date is March 8, 2012.
5. Only the land shown on map number 18144 may be irrigated under appropriation A-18888.
6. This appropriation will be limited to the land irrigated and the amount of water beneficially used on an annual basis. Such amount shall not exceed 12 acre-feet per annum.
7. The appropriator must comply with all relevant statutes. The statutes include, but are not limited to, the following:
  - A. Notify the Department of any change in ownership or address.
  - B. Notify the Department of the name and address of the person responsible for the use of the water appropriation (this may include farm managers, tenants, or relatives that actually apply the water to the approved use).

- C. Obtain approval from the Department prior to taking any action that changes the location of the point of diversion, the location of the place of use, the type of use, or the type of appropriation.
8. The appropriator must comply with the following deadlines:
- A. A map must be filed in the office of the Department by six months past the signing date of this application approval.
- B. Construction of the diversion works must begin within twelve months of the signing date of this application approval. The appropriator must proceed diligently with the construction unless interrupted by some unavoidable and natural cause.
- C. Construction of the project must be completed by three years past the signing date of this application approval.
- D. The appropriation is not considered perfected until water has been beneficially applied for the purpose stated in this approval. The water appropriated under A-18888 must be beneficially used by September 1, 2014.
- E. After September 1, 2014, a field investigation will be conducted to determine the acres irrigated, after which an order of cancellation will be issued for any unused portions of appropriation A-18888.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION


Failure to comply with all laws and regulations pertaining to surface water appropriations, any orders issued by the Director of the Department of Natural Resources, or the provisions of this Approval may result in the cancellation of the appropriation, temporary closing of the appropriation, administrative penalty, criminal prosecution, or any combination thereof.

Nebraska law provides that failure to use a portion or all of a perfected appropriation for more than five consecutive years may result in cancellation of the appropriation.

Nebraska law provides that waters previously appropriated for power purposes may be taken for irrigation purposes upon due and fair compensation.
