ORDER GRANTING PERMIT TO DRILL A WATER WELL WITHOUT REGARD TO MINIMUM
STATUTORY SPACING

The Director of the Department of Natural Resources (Department) approves Application WSP-113, for a permit to drill an irrigation well within 600 feet of existing irrigation well G-132604, submitted by Raymond and Elizabeth Hebda.


The terms and conditions of permit WSP-113 are as follows:

1. The irrigation well, which has been constructed in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 14, Township 16 North, Range 5 West of the 6th P.M. in Nance County, Nebraska, shall be properly registered pursuant to the requirements of *Neb. Rev. Stat.* § 46-602(1).
2. Approval of this permit is based on the information included and representations made in Application WSP-113 by Raymond and Elizabeth Hebda. That information and those representations are considered terms of this approval, to which Raymond and Elizabeth Hebda must adhere.
3. The well shall be operated in compliance with all Nebraska statutes and all rules and regulations promulgated by the Central Platte Natural Resources District.

THIS PERMIT MAY BE REVOKED OR MODIFIED BY THE DEPARTMENT FOR FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF THE PERMIT.

Box 94676, Lincoln, Nebraska 68509-4676) within 30 days of the date of the Approval and be accompanied by a filing fee of \$10.
